Kuzbass Governor Sergei Tsivilev has been nominated for the post of Minister of Energy of the Russian Federation in the new Cabinet

Governor of the Kemerovo Region, Sergei Tsivilev, has been nominated for the post of Minister of Energy of the Russian Federation in the new government, the press service of the Cabinet reported on 11 May. It was proposed that the post of Deputy Prime Minister in charge of the energy sector be retained by Alexander Novak. "Many years of experience as the head of the largest Russian coal mining region, as well as work at the federal level in the Presidium of the State Council of the Russian Federation and as Chairman of the Commission of the State Council of Russia in the field of Energy give reason to believe that Sergei Tsivilev will ensure the further development of an industry important for the country," – says the government press release.

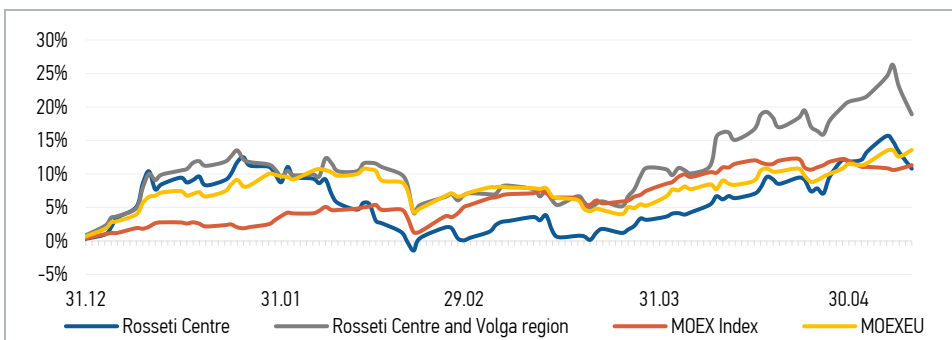
