Rosseti eliminates consequences of extreme weather in the European part of Russia

The Rosseti Group is restoring power supply to consumers in the Central, Northwestern and Volga Federal Districts, disrupted by passage of the Quiteria Cyclone on 21-22 November. This was reported by Deputy General Director - Chief Engineer of PJSC Rosseti Evgeny Lyapunov during a special headquarters meeting of the grid complex. In 21 regions of Russia, there were mass outages of power grid facilities due to the impact of storm winds, heavy rain, and wet snow. Such weather conditions led to branches and trees, roofing elements, and other foreign objects from outside security zones falling on power lines. In some cases, the accumulation of snow caused an over-calculated load on power lines, as a result, wires broke and poles were damaged.

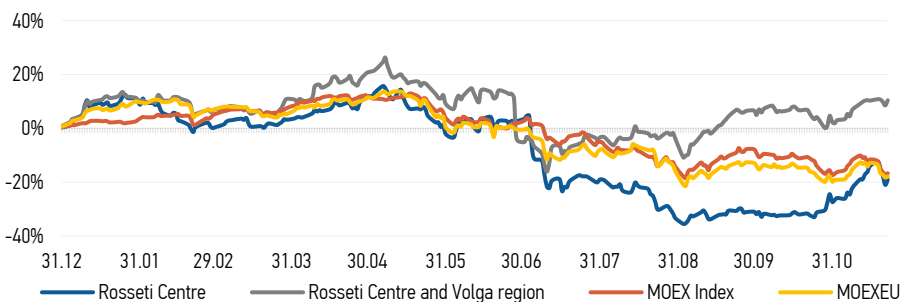

Violations in the main 6-10 kV grid (provides power supply to populated areas), caused by deteriorating weather conditions on 21-23 November in the Tula region (sleet, rain with wind gusts up to 22 m/s), have been eliminated. The Tulenergo branch operates in a high alert mode, which involves full mobilization of forces and resources.
